### Interpretation:

Interpretation	Remarks
Negative	No detectable Dengue NS1. The result does not rule our dengue infection. An additional sample for IgG and IgM is should be tested after 7-14 days.
Equivocal	Repeat Sample after 1 Week
Positive	Presence of detectable NS1 Antigen. Dengue IgG and IgM Assay Should Be Performed after 5-7 days of onset of fever, to confirm dengue infecton

**Clinical Advise:** For the first 5 days of fever, advised screening test is Dengue NS1 Antigen, After 7-10 of fever onset, the receommended screening test is Dengue IgG and IgM Serology.

**Advise:** Please note that this is a screening test only. Advised confirmation with Dengue by PCR for further diagnosis.
