Clinical Significance:
Hypercalcemia (Increased ionized calcium)
* Increased intestinal absorption.
* Increased mobilization from bone.
* Decreased renal elimination.
* Addison's disease.
Hypocalcemia (decreased ionized calcium)
* Decreased intestinal absorption.
* Increased renal elimination.
* Increased deposition of calcium in bones.
* Increased binding to proteins when Ph increases or binding to citrate.
* Hypoparathyroidism.
