CLINICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF RETICULOCYTE COUNT:

- * Increased reticulocyte count indicates increased bone marrow erythropoietic activity.
- * It is valuable in diagnosis of concealed haemorrhages, chronic haemolytic anemia.
- * Increased reticulocytes after administration of haematinic indicates therapeutic efficiency.
- * For monitoring the therapeutic response to haematinic like iron, vit.B12 & folic acid.
- * Repeated absence or low counts indicate bone marrow suppression in anaemia and hypoplastic marrow.
