Clinical Significance:
This test is based on qualitative determination or confirmation of lupus anticoagulants in human plasma by clotting assay using Russells viper venom is used to initiate clotting through direct activation of factor X Without the effect of factors XII, IX, XI, VIII or VII the test is performed with neat samples as well as 1:1 mixture with PNP (Pooled Normal Plasma) to correct the abnormalities due to plasma deficiencies of factors II,V or X. Lac initially recognized in patients with systemic lupus erythromatousus (SLE), these have now been described in other individuals and are considered a risk factor for thrombosis and recurrent spontaneous abortions. Plasma treated with heparin and plasma from patients with DIC may give abnormal results prolonged times.
