Clinical Significance of T3:
The levels of thyroid hormone (T3 & T4) are low in case of primary, secondary and tertiary hypothyroidism and sometimes in nonthyroidal illness also. Increased levels are found in grave's disease, hyperthyroidism and thyroid hormone resistance, T3 levels are also raised in T3 thyrotoxicosis.
