Clinical Significance:

- * Prognostic indicator of Multiple myeloma and other hematopoietic malignancies
- * An aid in the management of patients with renal dysfunction and rheumatoid arthritis
- Increased levels
- * Lymphoproliferative disorders like multiple myeloma, B cell lymphoma and chronic lymphocytic leukemia
- * Inflammatory disorders like rheumatoid arthritis, SLE, Sjogren's syndrome and Crohn's disease
- * Renal dysfunction

Clinical Notes:

- False negative / positive results are observed in patients receiving mouse monoclonal antibodies for diagnosis or therapy.
- Beta 2 microglobulin values regardless of levels should not be interpreted as absolute evidence of the presence or absence of disease.
- All values should be correlated with clinical findings and results of other investigations.
