Interpretation of Result:

- <20: Negative
- 20-39: Weak Positive
- 40-80: Moderate Positive
- >80: Strong Positive

Clinical Notes:Patients with SLE may have antibodies to SSA/Ro alone or may have both SSA/Ro & SSB/La antibodies. Presence of SSA/Ro antibody alone is commonly seen in association with HLA DR2 in patients less than 22 years of age at onset. Presence of both SSA/Ro & SSB/La in SLE is associated with HLA DR3 and is seen in older patients more than 50 years of age at onset. SLE patients with SSA/Ro antibodies develop a much more serious renal disease and have a higher incidence of concomitant Anti DNA antibodies.
