Clinical Significance: SSB/La antibodies are primarily considered as a serological marker of Primary Sjogren's syndrome and are detected in nearly 90% of these patients. They are also seen in 6-15% cases of ANA positive SLE patients. Presence of both SSB / La & SSA/Ro antibodies in SLE patients shows a lower incidence of renal disease and lower levels of concomitant Anti DNA antibodies. Detection of this antibody can precede the development of symptoms of Sicca syndrome by several years.
