Interpretation of Result:

- <20: Negative
- 20-39: Weak Positive
- 40-80: Moderate Positive
- >80: Strong Positive

Clinical Notes: Patients suffering from idiopathic inflammatory myopathies commonly show myositis associated antibodies directed against histidyl-tRNA synthetase / Jo-1 antigen. The serum levels of Jo-1 antibodies vary depending on the activity of the disease. Jo-1 antibodies are detected months before the outbreak of myositis suggesting a marker function for this antibody. Over 70% of patients with a positive result show signs of fibrosing alveolitis, polyarthritis, occasionally Raynauds phenomenon or other signs of Scleroderma.
