Clinical Notes:

1. Titers of $\geq 1:8$ and rising titers are significant.
2. RPR Quantitative test will rule out Prozone phenomenon if any in the submitted sample.
3. Positive result indicates ongoing or recent infection and the diagnosis can be confirmed by specific Treponemal tests such as TPHA / Syphilis Antibody.
4. Negative results are seen in absence of treponemal infection. However, it does not rule out the disease.
5. The reactivity will vary with Primary (60-86%), Secondary (99%) and Tertiary (98%) stage of Syphilis.
6. False positive results may be observed in patients of Malaria, Hepatitis, Mumps, Leprosy, Infectious Mononucleosis, Rheumatoid Arthritis and Collagen disease.
7. False negative reaction may be due to processing of sample collected early in the course of disease and immunosuppression.
