Method:Rapid Lateral Immunochromatography Assay.

NOTE: Multi-Drug Screen Urine Test is a qualitative immunoassay intended to be used to detect the presence of drugs and /or drug metabolites in human urine at their specified cutoff levels, in a single assay. Multi-Drug Screen Urine Test provides only a preliminary analytical test result. A more specific alternate chemical method must be used to obtain a confirmed analytical result. Gas Chromatography / Mass Spectrophotometry (GC/MS) is the preferred confirmatory method. Clinical consideration and professional judgement should be applied to any drug of abuse test result, particularly when preliminary positive results are reported. Immunoassay based urine testing for drugs of abuse has become one of the most accepted methods of preliminary screening. These assays allow laboratories to eliminate a large number of negative specimens and focus on the smaller number of initially positive samples.
